- 2 O Ionawr i Fai, 1932, anfonodd De Cymru yn agos i **filiwn** tunell o lo i Iwerddon.
Yn 1934, yn yr un cyfnod, nid anfonodd ond **hanner** miliwn tunell.
- 3 Felly y teflir gweithwyr Cymru allan o waith er mwyn urddas (!) Ymerodraeth Loegr.
- 4 Deil Loegr afael, trwy'i byddinoedd, ar Gyprus, India, a mannau eraill,—yn unig er mwyn ei helw ariannol hi ei hun.
- 5 O bob gwlad dramor arall, yn India y mae'r gyfran fwyaf o arian buddsoddwyr Lloegr, sef **saith can miliwn**.
- 6 Yn India, tân-belennir pentrefi cyfain o'r awyr,—a gelwir hyn gan Loegr yn "gadw heddwch."

GRINDING TAXATION


England spends £106,000,000 every year on armaments. Wales is compelled to pay her share towards this colossal sum, which means that £250 per minute is spent on war.

THE ENGLISH EMPIRE IS UPHELD BY ECONOMIC and MILITARY OPPRESSION

- 1 England tried to force the farmers of Ireland to pay for land which already belonged to the Irish. In the tariff "war" that followed Wales is the heaviest sufferer—Holyhead, Fishguard and the South Wales coalfield.
- 2 Between January and May, 1932, South Wales exported to Ireland nearly a **million** tons of coal.
In 1934, during the same period, she only exported **half a million** tons.
- 3 In this futile way, therefore, the workers of Wales are thrown out of work, for the sake of English imperial prestige (!)
- 4 England by means of her armed forces, maintains her grip on Cyprus, India, and other territories,—solely for the sake of her own financial gain.
- 5 English financiers have a greater share of investments in India than in any other foreign country. The sum amounts to **seven hundred million**.
- 6 In India, England reserves, and uses, the right to bomb native villages from the air—a process which she designates as "keeping the peace."

WALES, so long as she remains tied to England's imperial chariot, MUST BEAR HER SHARE OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THIS OPPRESSION.
