- **Minutes of last meeting** – accepted as correct
- **Matters arising from last meeting**
 - **World Microfilms** a report of the meeting of the Chair and Treasurer with the Chief Executive and Treasurer of Plaid Cymru and of the phone call the Treasurer had with the representative of World Microfilms was received. It was agreed that the Treasurer would contact the Head of the Political Archive at the National Library to ascertain whether or not they would want to work directly with the company
 - **Glyn Tomos' booklet on HR Jones** We received thanks for our support and details of the launch in Chapter on 11 December at 7pm. The Secretary has sent the details to members.
 - **Evening with Aled Eirug discussing his book on Dafydd El with Vaughan Roderick** went well. Thanks to Penri Williams who recorded the discussion and the translation both of which are now available on our web site
 - **Tribute to Alan Jobbins** by his son Sion has been received and is on our web site

It was decided that we would inform them that we will explore other possibilities where it could be on permanent display

 - From **Evan Wall** offering to give a lecture on how Irish nationalism influenced Plaid Genedlaethol Cymru and Penyberth It as agreed that the Secretary would inform him that we would explore the possibility of hosting the lecture at a location in Caernarfon NW Wales in September 2026 (the 90th anniversary of the burning of Penyberth) and get back to him

 - The Secretary will explore the possibility of putting the article on Plaid Cymru by Rhys Evans in the latest edition of Maniffesto on the Society's web site
 - It was agreed that the Secretary would share the details of the event being organised by Cymdeithas Carnhuanawc with Arwel Vittle talking about Mai Roberts, Ieuan Wyn Jones on the early days of Plaid Cymru and Keith Bush on ETJohn on 7 March 2026 in Cardiff with members
 - A tribute to Huw John Swansea will be pursued by the Chair
